Subject:	COVID-19 Update

As of this date there are three (3) active cases of COVID-19 in our Long-Term Care Home. This was confirmed yesterday, as all the Residents who tested positive were re-tested and although none are displaying symptoms these three Residents continue to test positive. Currently there are no new cases of COVID-19 in LTC.

Toronto Public Health has informed us that there can be no new cases or repeat positive swabs for a period of 28 days to declare the outbreak over. If there are no new or repeat cases May 28th is the earliest we will be out of outbreak in LTC.

There are **NO** confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our Independent Living Apartments. This week, two (2) Residents in the independent apartments were tested as they displayed possible symptoms of COVID-19, both results were negative.

As of this date there are three (3) active cases of COVID-19 in members of staff. All these staff members are not attending work and will remain off work for 14 days and then be re-tested.

We continue to screen all Residents in the LTC, and Independent Living apartments twice a day. Yesterday the MOH ordered that all staff must be tested when they come to work and when they leave for home - between 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.
