Subject:	COVID-19 Update

As we continue to receive the results of our May 21, 2020 nasal swabs of Residents in Independent Living more active cases of COVID-19 are being identified. As I write this correspondence there are now **3 active cases of COVID-19** throughout independent living. Long Term Care remains COVID free.

As I outlined in my May 25th report, we urge you ALL to take the following precautions to contain the spread of this virus:

- Residents and their family members are not allowed to visit one another on the patio or in the parking area of the complex.**
- Timing of visits to our vegetable gardens must be booked at reception so that the City's rules on social distancing are maintained.**
- All Residents must always wear a mask when out of their apartment.**
- Residents must remain in their apartments and not walk the halls except to go to the garbage shoot or do laundry.**
- Screening of all Residents will continue to occur twice daily. Those with an active case will be screened and checked on by members of the Assisted Living Services Team**
- Visits to your doctor or other health care practitioners must be report to the clinic nurse as they are considered community contacts.**
- Meals will continue to be served in your suites until further notice.**
