As of January 11, 2022, Public Health has officially declared St. Clair O'Connor Community in "COVID-19 OUTBREAK" which will last for 14 days, ending January 25, 2022. However, the OUTBREAK may be extended if there are additional COVID-19 cases within our community.

SCOC is recognized as a congregated living facility by Public Health. Long-Term-Care, Assisted Living and Independent living share the facility and all precautions that are taken are done to protect the community.

We are glad to let you know that there are no active COVID-19 cases within our community. We have two staff members that are positive and are currently at home in quarantine and they are doing fine.
